

Part 6 - FCP Basic Editing Techniques – Making a High Resolution QuickTime

Make a QuickTime movie (full Resolution)

To make a QuickTime movie of your edited sequence place an in and out point of the area you want to make a movie from or select the clips (**apple A** selects everything).

The best method for making a full quality 16x9 video HDV is to select the **file** dropdown menu and click on **export** and **QuickTime movie**. A box appears. Leave the current settings in place (you can change the setting from current settings to another video format if you want here as well as more advanced features from the options button). Type in the name you want to call the clip and select where you want to put it.

I suggest making a folder called QuickTime on your external HDD and placing your clip in it. You will have to wait while it exports your clip.

Do the same method for any other format you are working in.

Note. For DV 16x9 anamorphic or 4x3 the clip plays back DV as 4x3 in QuickTime player and the clip will want to open in FCP by default.
